

Food Vendor Site Fees

All fees are inclusive of the entire duration of Toowoomba Carnival of Flowers, operating 8.30am – 5.30pm daily from Fri 18 Sept - Mon 5 Oct (18 days). *There are no reduced site fees for partial attendance.*

Site fees are determined by location, site size and service products. The base site fee has been prorated from the 2025 event, which operated over 25 days.

FOOD VENDOR SITE FEE STRUCTURE 2026

Site fees payable are determined by location, site size and service products.

add Coffee / Drinks	Inclusions: Drinks and coffees only	add \$1,000
add Snacks	Inclusions: Prepackaged snacks (eg. muffins, biscuits) Donuts Ice creams Baked goods (slices, biscuits)	add \$1,500
add Main Meals / Hot Food	Inclusions: All heat prepared foods (hot chips, burgers, dumplings, fried chicken etc.) Wraps, salads and sandwiches (Note; this option includes the ability to sell snack items at no additional charge. Coffee and Drinks not included)	add \$2,500

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SALE OF ADDITIONAL PRODUCTS

If you wish to apply to sell other products in addition to your primary products (eg. a coffee stall also selling biscuits/slices or a hot food stall also selling cold drinks), the discounted fees are as follows.

add coffee/drinks	\$750
add snacks	\$1,250

** Single payment of the additional product only (no duplicate product fee for double site)

CANCELLATIONS

Food vendors will be invoiced prior to the event.

In the event of cancellation of your booking, the following cancellation fees are incurred. All cancellations are to be received via email to info@tcof.com.au.

Notification Date	Cancellation Terms
Cancellation prior to 4pm Wed 1 Sept, 2026 (14 days before bump in)	Full refund of site fees paid
Cancellation prior to 4pm Wed 8 Sept, 2026 (7 days before bump in)	50% cancellation fee (50% refund of site fees paid)
Cancellation after 4pm Wed 8 Sept, 2026 (7 days before bump in)	100% cancellation fee (no refund of site fees paid)

HOW TO CALCULATE YOUR FOOD VENDOR SITE FEE

To determine your 2026 fee, first select which park you wish to apply for.

1. Calculate how many sites you need (single site is 4m x 6m)
2. Pick your primary product service (eg. hot food)
3. Add on any additional products you wish to sell (eg. drinks)

Examples

1. You have a 6m x 3m trailer that want to operate at Laurel Bank Park, selling meals (e.g. burgers) as well as soft drinks. You will require:
 2 x Laurel Bank site fees (\$900 x 2) = \$1,800
 Primary product (meals/hot food) \$2,500 + additional product (coffee/drinks) \$750 = \$3,250
Total food vendor site fee = \$5,050

2. You have a 3m x 3m gazebo that you want to operate at Queens Park Botanic Gardens, selling coffees, smoothies and homemade slices and pastries. You will require:
 1x Queens Park Botanic Gardens site fee = \$1260
 Primary product (snacks) \$1,500 + additional product (drinks) \$750 = \$2,250
Total food vendor site fee = \$3,510

3. You have a 4m x 3m trailer that you want to operate at Queens Park Botanic Gardens, selling hot meals, fresh biscuits and slices. You also want to sell hot drinks. You will require:
 1 x Queens Park Botanic Gardens site fee = \$1,260
 Primary product (meals/hot food) \$2,500 - includes snack foods + additional product (drinks) \$750 = \$3,250
Total food vendor site fee = \$4,510


4. You have a 6m x 3m hardstand that you want to operate at Queens Park Botanic Gardens, selling meals (e.g. burgers) as well as soft drinks. You will require:
 2 x Queens Park site fees (\$1,260 x 2) = \$2,520
 Primary product (meals/hot food) \$2,500 + additional product (coffee/drinks) \$750 = \$3,250
Total food vendor site fee = \$5,770




2025 DAILY VISITOR NUMBERS*
