

GRAND CENTRAL FLORAL PARADE CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

The following conditions of entry apply to all Grand Central Floral Parade entrants:

- Neither the Toowoomba Regional Council ("Council"), Toowoomba Carnival of Flowers Parade Coordination Team its appointed parade organisers, sponsors will provide any Public Liability insurance protection with regards to my/our participation in the parade; and
- I/We am/are required to obtain Compulsory Third-Party insurance and Department of Transport permits for all unlicensed floats and vehicles; (where applicable) and
- I/We am/are required to obtain Police Permit for unregistered vehicles; (where applicable)
- Distribution of items or soliciting of funds is NOT PERMITTED PRIOR OR DURING THE PARADE
- I/We acknowledge and accept the conditions of entry as outlined in this application.
- I/We agree that participation in the parade is solely at my/our own risk; and
- I/We agree that I/we am/are solely liable for and indemnifies and saves harmless Council and the Toowoomba Carnival of Flowers Coordination Team from and against all liability, actions, claims, penalties, damages and expense that may be incurred by or brought against or made upon Council in relation to the entrant's participation in the parade except where such liability, actions, claims, penalties, damages and expense arise out of a negligent act or negligent default of Council, its employees or its agents.
- I/we agree that Council are permitted to take photographs and footage of our participation in the parade. These images may be reproduced for future parade promotional purposes.
- I/we acknowledge that our entry maybe cancelled if criteria aren't adhered to.
- Entry into the Parade is not automatic or guaranteed.
- Council reserves the right to select the parade entries according to the cultural and entertainment values of your parade proposal.
- All prospective parade entries must hold their own public liability insurance to the value of \$20,000,000 or more, and current full comprehensive vehicle insurance for the vehicle you will be using in the parade.
- All entrants release Council from any claims
- For safety reason - No carrying of real knives, swords (with sharp edges that can cut, slice or stab), guns or other weapons
- For safety reason - No throwing gifts into the crowd (eg. lollies, toys etc)
- No Political entries (eg. Politicians walking for Labour or Liberal party etc)
- No public speeches, no preaching and no recruitment.
- No collecting donations along the parade route.
- No handing out marketing materials (eg flyers/ coupons) along the parade route.
- No solo/one person entry with no insurance
- If you have children in your parade entry who are without their guardians, you will be required to have a Working with Children check. The person with the Working with Children check must be a parade participant.
- It is highly recommended that every parade entry carry a fire extinguisher & a first aid kit.
- All road rules apply while driving along the parade route.
- Council monitors the weather leading up to the days of the parade.
- In the event of extreme weather – All parade entrants should refer to their own parade assessment of the risks to determine whether to continue or withdraw from the parade.
- The parade manager will undertake an event/ weather risk assessment on the day prior to determining whether the parade should continue. If a decision is made to cancel the parade, the Event Organisers will advise the public & parade participants.
